



### 21 Days Prayer – 1<sup>st</sup> week

The purpose of this prayer is to keep our soul, our spirit, and our body blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ (1 Thessalonians 5:23).

**1<sup>st</sup> week focus on our soul:** Seeds that fell by the roadside - Matthew 13:19 (This resembles the soul).

**Points for prayer:** To turnaround the soul of the individual (personal, family, as well as the society) which is on the roadside towards the word of God, through being perfected by the Holy Spirit.

*Prayer points for each day has a total of 3 parts. (These 3 parts of prayer points can be completed at different time intervals during the same day).*

#### Part I

1. Sanctification - For personal life, family and society. To read Isaiah 53 fully.
2. Praising – To read Psalms 136 fully.
3. Thanksgiving – To read Psalms 103 fully.
4. Word meditation – Psalms 119, each day 3 parts and the last 4 parts on the final day of prayer completion. (Psalms 119 has a total of 22 parts, each part contains 8 set of verses i.e., 1<sup>st</sup> part contains the first 8 verses, 2<sup>nd</sup> part contains verses 9 – 16, and so on).

[1000 praises – To complete this prayer point with the first 300 praises from the 1000 praises.]

#### Part II

5. Word Reading – To read 1 Peter and 2 Peter on alternate days of the 1<sup>st</sup> week i.e., both 1 Peter (5 chapters) and 2 Peter (3 chapters) together have a total of 8 chapters, so 1 Peter (5 chapters) could be read on the 1<sup>st</sup> day, and then on the next day 2 Peter (3 chapters) could be read fully along with the first 2 chapters of 1 Peter. On the 3<sup>rd</sup> day we again begin reading 1 Peter (5 chapters). We continue this reading cycle on alternate days until completion of the 1<sup>st</sup> week.

6. Aim of prayer – To meditate on the seed that fell by the roadside (Matthew 13:19).
  - i. Spiritual stage of the soul: Not understanding the truth (2 Timothy 3:7).
  - ii. Reason for not understanding the word: Not being lovers of God but being lovers of self/pleasure (2 Timothy 3:4).
  - iii. Consequence of not understanding the word:
    - a) Fatness of heart – Acts 28:27.
    - b) Hardness of heart – Mark 6:52.
    - c) Closing of heart – Isaiah 44:18.
  - iv. Result/Conclusion of not understanding the word: Being ruled by the evil one (Matthew 13:19) which leads to total destruction of life (Matthew 24:39).

[1000 praises – To complete this prayer point with praise no. 301 to 600 from the 1000 praises.]



### Part III

7. Renewing and restoration of the soul – For the soul to be perfected (1 Peter 5:10).

- i. By hearing the word of God (Job 34:16).
- ii. By glorifying God (Romans 1:21), even while facing uncomfortable situations and sufferings though we are walking righteously and doing good (1 Peter 3:17).
- iii. By ruling and reigning with God (Zechariah 9:10), (Psalms 8:6).
- iv. By being cautious and diligent (Proverbs 12:24).

[1000 praises – To complete this prayer point with praise no. 601 to 900 from the 1000 praises.]

8. Praying for others (Matthew 25:35). Pray especially for the people who are hungry and thirsty in their soul, who are living in the 7 continents across the world, that they should be fed in their soul and satisfied in their soul by God.

*(This above prayer point should also be prayed for during all the days of the week).*

[1000 praises – To complete this prayer point with praise no. 901 to 1000 from the 1000 praises.]

9. Final prayer – Thanksgiving prayer for the renewing and the restoration of the soul, as well as for the feeding of the hungry and thirsty souls by God. Complete this final prayer point by reading both Psalms 91 and Psalms 121 fully.
