



21 Days Prayer – 2nd week

The purpose of this prayer is to keep our soul, our spirit, and our body blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ (1 Thessalonians 5:23).

2nd week focus on our spirit: Seeds that are sown in stony places - Matthew 13:20 (This resembles the spirit).

Points for prayer: To turnaround the spirit of the individual (personal, family, as well as the society) which is like a stony place towards the word of God, through being strengthened by the Holy Spirit.

Prayer points for each day has a total of 3 parts. (These 3 parts of prayer points can be completed at different time intervals during the same day).

Part I

1. Sanctification - For personal life, family and society. To read Isaiah 53 fully.
2. Praising – To read Psalms 136 fully.
3. Thanksgiving – To read Psalms 103 fully.
4. Word meditation – Psalms 119, each day 3 parts and the last 4 parts on the final day of prayer completion. (Psalms 119 has a total of 22 parts, each part contains 8 set of verses i.e., 1st part contains the first 8 verses, 2nd part contains verses 9 – 16, and so on).

[1000 praises – To complete this prayer point with the first 300 praises from the 1000 praises.]

Part II

5. Word Reading – To read the chapters in James on alternate days of the 2nd week i.e., James (Chapter 1 and Chapter 2) to be read on the 1st day, and then James (Chapter 3, Chapter 4 and Chapter 5) to be read on the 2nd day. We continue this reading cycle on alternate days until completion of the 2nd week.
6. Aim of prayer – To meditate on the seed that fell in stony places (Matthew 13:20).
 - i. Spiritual stage of the spirit: Being offended in the spirit (Matthew 13:21).
 - ii. Reason for not understanding the word: Being defiled by what comes out of the mouth (Matthew 15:11).
 - iii. Consequence of not understanding the word:
 - a) Murmuring on hearing hard doctrine – John 6:60,61.
 - b) Thinking about ‘self’ – 1 Corinthians 10:33.
 - c) Being a hindrance to the church of God – 1 Corinthians 10:32.
 - iv. Result/Conclusion of not understanding the word:
 - a) Betraying one another – Matthew 24:10.
 - b) Hating one another – Matthew 24:10.
 - c) Therefore, no miracles in their life – Mark 6:3,5,6.

[1000 praises – To complete this prayer point with praise no. 301 to 600 from the 1000 praises.]

Part III

7. Renewing and restoration of the spirit – For the offended spirit to be strengthened (1 Peter 5:10).

- i. By the preaching of the cross which becomes God's strength/power. (1 Corinthians 1:18).
- ii. By the preaching of the cross which becomes God's wisdom (1 Corinthians 1:23, 24).
- iii. By carrying our cross (Matthew 10:38,39).
- iv. By having a confident expectation of hope for the return of the Lord Jesus Christ (Philippians 3:18-20).

[1000 praises – To complete this prayer point with praise no. 601 to 900 from the 1000 praises.]

8. Praying for others (Matthew 25:36). Pray especially for the people who are sick and imprisoned in their spirit, who are living in the 7 continents across the world, that they should be healed and delivered by God.

[1000 praises – To complete this prayer point with praise no. 901 to 1000 from the 1000 praises.]

(This above prayer point should also be continuously prayed for all the days of the week).

9. Final prayer – Thanksgiving prayer for the renewing and the restoration of the spirit by God, as well as for the healing and deliverance from God to those who are sick and imprisoned in their spirit. Complete this final prayer point by reading both Psalms 91 and Psalms 121 fully.
