2nd week prayer for family (Thursday)

1) Sanctification prayer for family (Isaiah 53).

- i. Iniquity in soul (thought systems/strongholds).
- ii. Transgression in spirit (speech).
- iii. Sin in body (actions/deeds).
According to 1 John 1:7, complete the above prayer points by praying for sanctification of husband, wife, children (family).
- iv. Praising – To read Psalms 136 fully, Thanksgiving – To read Psalms 103 fully.
- v. Word meditation – Psalms 119 (1 to 7 parts). Psalms 119 has a total of 22 parts, each part contains 8 set of verses i.e., 1st part contains the first 8 verses, 2nd part contains verses 9 – 16, and so on.
- vi. 1000 praises – To complete this prayer point with the first 300 praises from the 1000 praises.

2) For the family to abide in the love of Christ (1 Corinthians 13:12-13).

- i. Faith in the soul.
- ii. Hope in the spirit.
- iii. Love in the body.
- iv. Word meditation – Psalms 119 (8 to 14 parts). Psalms 119 has a total of 22 parts, each part contains 8 set of verses i.e., 1st part contains the first 8 verses, 2nd part contains verses 9 – 16, and so on.
- v. 1000 praises – To complete this prayer point with praise no. 301 to 600 from the 1000 praises.

3) For the family to give their fruit in their season (Psalms 1:1-3).

- i. According to Psalms 1:1, to find out ungodly counsel in the soul, to find scornfulness in the spirit, to find out sinful ways in the body.
- ii. According to Psalms 1:2, to dedicate time in order to meditate on the word of Christ day and night.
- iii. According to Psalms 1:3, for all the work of our hands to prosper as per God's will.
- iv. Word meditation – Psalms 119 (15 to 22 parts). Psalms 119 has a total of 22 parts, each part contains 8 set of verses i.e., 1st part contains the first 8 verses, 2nd part contains verses 9 – 16, and so on.
- v. Prayer for family – According to Psalms 1:1-3, to remove the things that God doesn't desire, to do the things pleasing to God, and to give fruit by abiding in Christ.
- vi. 1000 praises – To complete this prayer point with praise no. 601 to 900 from the 1000 praises.
- vii. Finishing prayer – To read both Psalms 91 and Psalms 121 fully, accordingly give thanks and end prayer. 1000 praises – To complete this prayer point with praise no. 901 to 1000 from the 1000 praises.
