1) Church sanctification (Isaiah 53).

- i. For individual life.
- ii. For family.
- iii. For job/business/ministry – 1 John 1:7 (to pray for sanctification of job/business/ministry according to this verse).
- iv. Praising – To read Psalms 136 fully, Thanksgiving – To read Psalms 103 fully.

(A) Roadside field (soul)

- v. Word meditation – Psalms 119 (1 to 7 parts). Psalms 119 has a total of 22 parts, each part contains 8 set of verses, i.e., 1st part contains the first 8 verses, 2nd part contains verses 9 – 16, and so on.
- vi. Petitions for church – For seeds sown in the roadside (soul). Renewing and restoration of the soul – For the soul to be perfected (1 Peter 5:10).
 - a) By hearing the word of God (Job 34:16).
 - b) By glorifying God (Romans 1:21), even while facing uncomfortable situations and sufferings though we are walking righteously and doing good (1 Peter 3:17).
 - c) By ruling and reigning with God (Zechariah 9:10), (Psalms 8:6).
 - d) By being cautious and diligent (Proverbs 12:24).
 - e) Soul - Pray especially for the people who are hungry and thirsty in their soul (Matthew 25:35).

(B) Stony field (spirit)

- viii. Word meditation – Psalms 119 (8 to 14 parts). Psalms 119 has a total of 22 parts, each part contains 8 set of verses, i.e., 1st part contains the first 8 verses, 2nd part contains verses 9 – 16, and so on.
- ix. Petitions for church – Seeds sown in stony field (spirit). Renewing and restoration of the spirit – For the offended spirit to be strengthened (1 Peter 5:10).
 - a) By the preaching of the cross which becomes God's strength/power. (1 Corinthians 1:18).
 - b) By the preaching of the cross which becomes God's wisdom (1 Corinthians 1:23,24).
 - c) By carrying our cross (Matthew 10:38,39).
 - d) By having a confident expectation of hope for the return of the Lord Jesus Christ (Philippians 3:18-20).
 - e) Spirit - Pray especially for the people who are sick and imprisoned in their spirit (Matthew 25:36).
- x. 1000 praises – To complete this prayer point with praise no. 301 to 600 from the 1000 praises.



(C) Thorny field (body)

- xi. Word meditation – Psalms 119 (15 to 22 parts). Psalms 119 has a total of 22 parts, each part contains 8 set of verses, i.e., 1st part contains the first 8 verses, 2nd part contains verses 9 – 16, and so on.
- xii. Petitions for church – Seeds sown in thorny field (body). Renewing and restoration of the body
 - For the body to be settled (1 Peter 5:10).
 - a) By walking in integrity (Psalms 41:12).
 - b) By being truthful in God (Psalms 99:4).
 - c) By doing according to God's will (Hebrews 10:9).
 - d) By suffering for a little while (1 Peter 5:10).
 - e) Body - Pray especially for the people who are strangers, and naked in their body without the garments of salvation (Matthew 25:35,36).
- xiii. 1000 praises – To complete this prayer point with praise no. 601 to 900 from the 1000 praises.
- xiv. Finishing prayer – To read both Psalms 91 and Psalms 121 fully, accordingly give thanks and end prayer. 1000 praises – To complete this prayer point with praise no. 901 to 1000 from the 1000 praises.
